### Kitimat Works \$297.2 Million

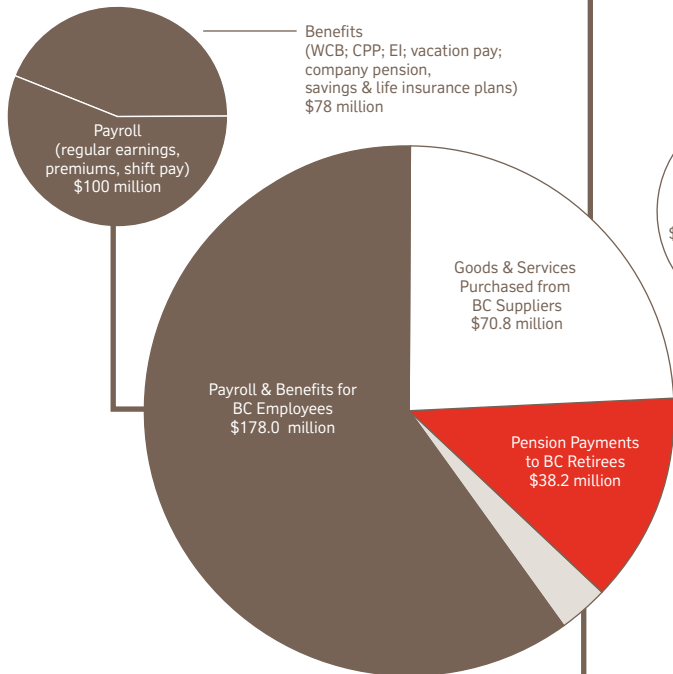
- payroll & benefits for BC employees     \$178.0 million

- pension payments to BC retirees         \$ 38.2 million

 \* Excluding workers on LTD

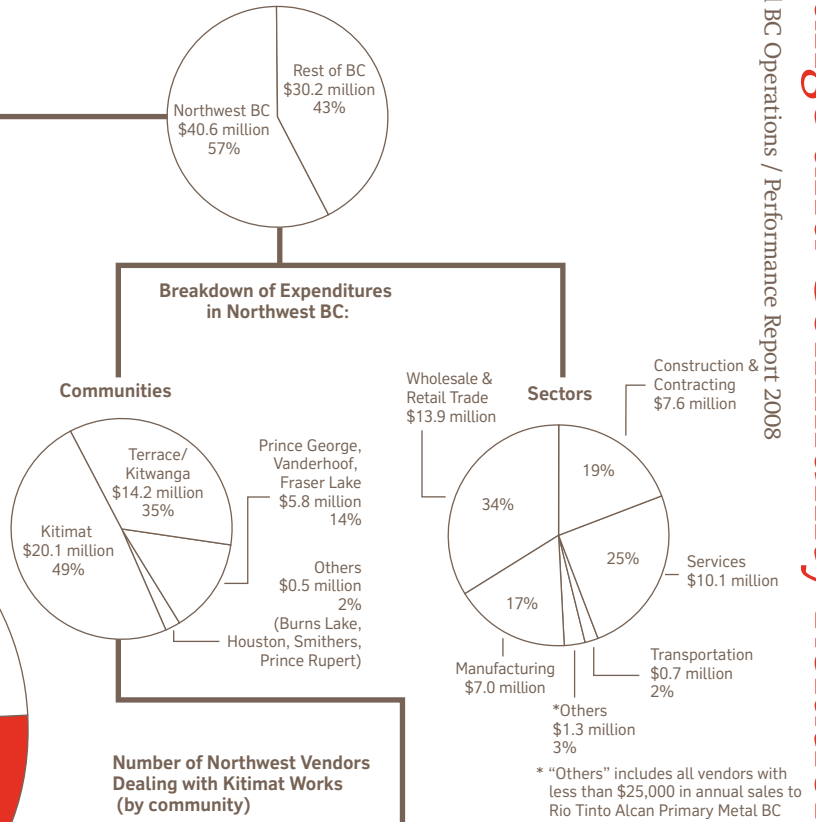
Total estimated direct, indirect/induced employment in Kitimat-Terrace area: 3,500

 - Provincial \$6.9 million



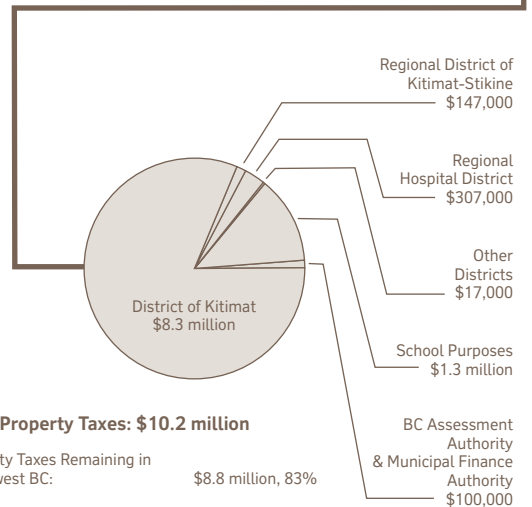

#### Number of Northwest Vendors Dealing with Kitimat Works (by community)

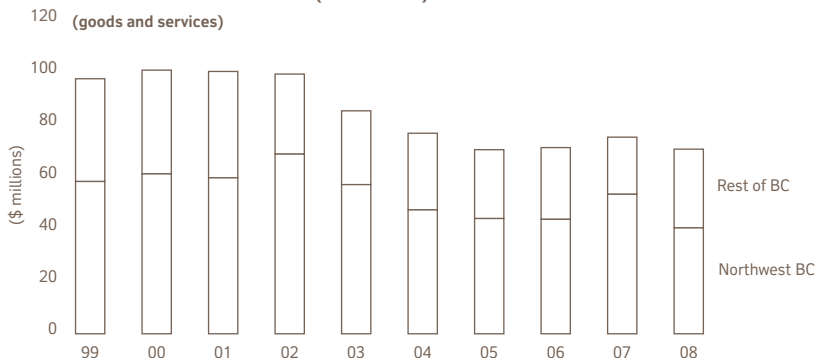
