## Kitimat Works \$267.8 Million

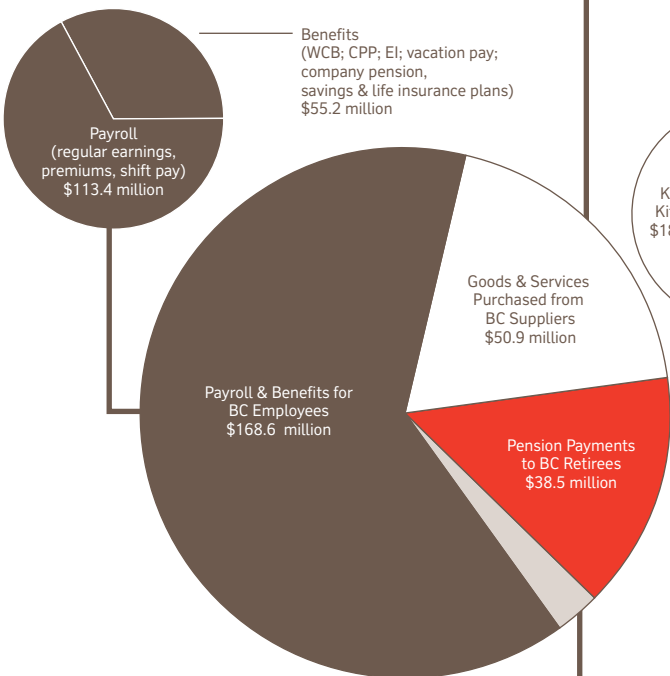
- payroll & benefits for BC employees \$ 168.6 million
- goods & services from BC suppliers \$ 50.9 million
- pension payments to BC retirees \$ 38.5 million
- property taxes \$ 9.8 million

 - 33% of total employment in Kitimat  
 - 11% of total employment in Kitimat-Terrace area  
 \* Excluding workers on LTD

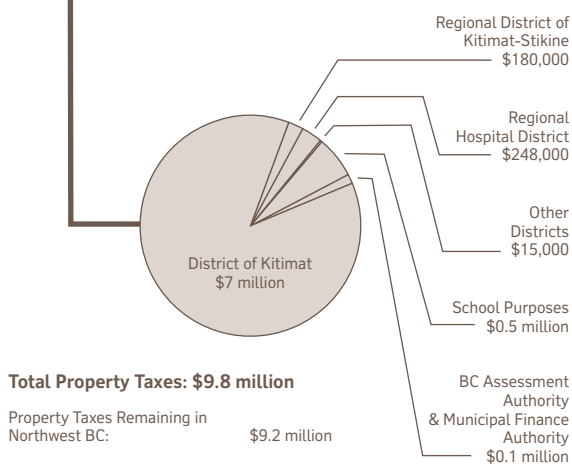
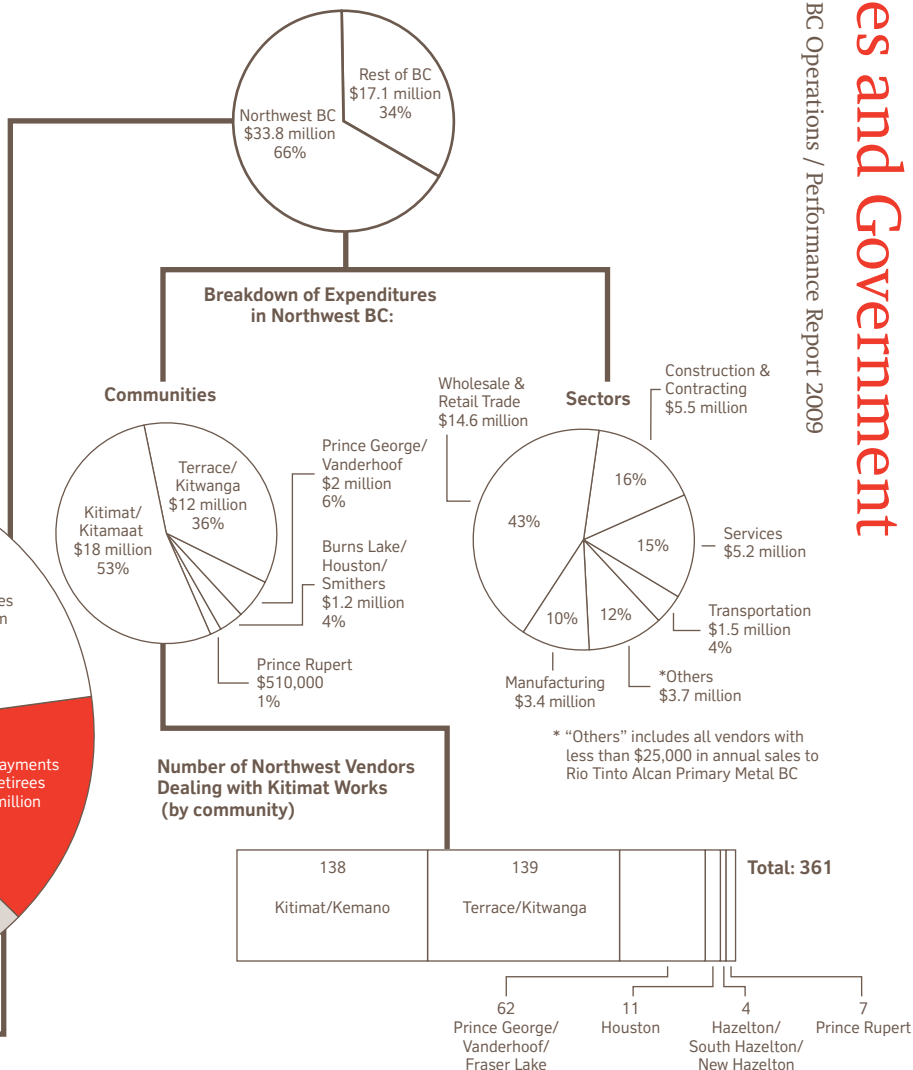
Total estimated direct, indirect/induced employment in Kitimat-Terrace area: 3,500

Kitimat Works goods & services purchased in BC: \$50.9 million (excluding raw materials)

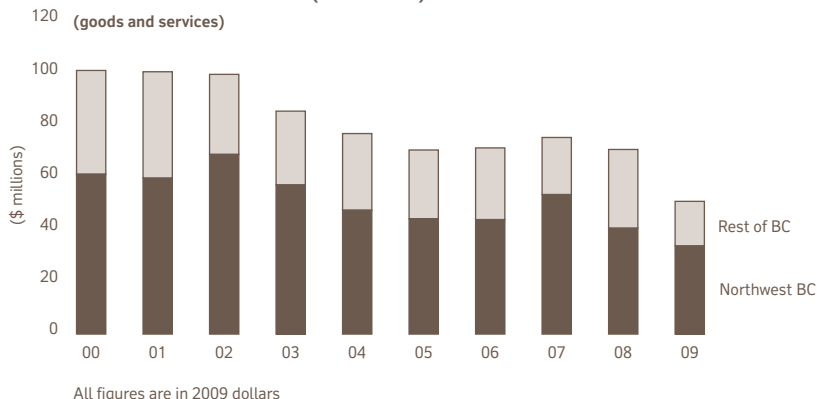


### Total Property Taxes: \$9.8 million
